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JACKET · RISERVA
Design 09 – Classici 20

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Size 48 (50/52, 54)

Instructions are given for first size. Figures in parenthesis refer to larger sizes. When only one figure is given, it applies to all sizes.

Materials: 650 (700, 700) g of Lana Grossa **Riserva** (70% organic cotton, 30% recycled polyamide; 125 m/50 g) in Grey Green (col 20). Size 4 and 6 mm needles; five 22 mm buttons in green.

Rib patt: K1, p1.

St st: K on RS, p on WS.

Selvage sts: On RS row, k first and last st; on WS row, p first and last st.

Left front band: Row 1 (RS): Work to last 13 sts, [p1, sl 1 kwise wyib] 5 times, p1, two-stitch selvage. Row 2 (WS): Two-stitch selvage, [k1, p1] 5 times, k1 = 13 sts, work to end.

Right front band: Row 1 (RS): Two-stitch selvage, [p1, sl 1 kwise wyib] 5 times, p1 = 13 sts. Row 2 (WS): Work to last 13 sts, [k1, p1] 5 times, k1, two-stitch selvage.

Two-stitch selvage: On RS row, sl 1 pwise wyib, k1, patt to last 2 sts, k1, sl 1 pwise wyib. On WS row, p1, sl 1 pwise wyif, patt to last 2 sts, sl 1 pwise wyif, p1.


Full-fashion decrease: At beg of RS row, selvage st, k2, skp; at end of RS row, work to last 5 sts, k2tog, k2, selvage st.

Full-fashion increase: On RS row: M1R, 4 st in from each edge.

Gauge: 18 sts and 26 rows = 10 x 10 cm in St st on size 6 mm needles.

Back: With size 4 mm needles cast on 99 (107, 115) sts. Next row (WS): **Selvage st, * k1, p1; rep from * to last 2 sts, k1, selvage st.** Work in rib patt as set by last row until piece meas 6 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Change to size 6 mm needles. Work in St st and shape sides as foll: Working full-fashion inc, inc 1 st at each end of 17th row, then every 16th row 3 times = 107 (115, 123) sts. Work even until piece meas 37 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Shape arm-holes: Bind off 4 sts at beg of next 2 rows. Working full-fashion dec, dec 1 st at each end of next 9 RS rows = 81 (89, 97) sts. Work even until armhole meas 18 (19, 20) cm, ending with a WS row. Working full-fashion inc, inc 1 st at each end of next RS row, then every 6th row 1 time, then every 4th row 2 times = 89 (97, 105) sts. Work even until armhole meas 24 (25, 26) cm, ending with a WS row. Shape shoulders and neck: At each shoulder edge bind off 3 (4, 5) sts 1 time, then 4 sts 5 times (then 4 sts 2 times, 5 sts 3 times / then 5 sts 4 times, 6 sts 1 time). At same time, when piece meas 63.5 (64.5, 65.5) cm from cast-on, shape neck as foll: Next row (RS): Bind off center 31 sts. Working each side separately, bind off 4 sts at each neck edge 1 time, 2 sts 1 time. No sts rem.

Pocket lining: Make 2. With size 6 mm needles cast on 36 (38, 40) sts. Work in St st for 5 cm, ending with a WS row. Place sts on holder, cut yarn.



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Left front: With size 4 mm needles cast on 59 (63, 67) sts. Next row (WS): **Two-stitch-selvage**, * k1, p1, rep from *, **selvage st**. Next row (RS): Selvage st, work in rib patt as established to last 13 sts, work left front band over last 13 sts. Work in patt as set by last row for 2 cm, ending with a RS row. Next WS (buttonhole) row: Two-stitch selvage, [k1, p1] 2 times, k2tog, yo, work to end. On foll RS row, k into yo. **Work 4 more buttonholes spaced 12.5 (13, 13) cm apart.** Cont in patt until piece meas 6 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Change to size 6 mm needles. Next row (RS): Work in St st to last 13 sts, work left front band as established over last 13 sts. Work in patt as set by last row for 5 cm, ending with a WS row. Next row (RS): Work first 10 (12, 14) sts, then with RS facing, k36 (38, 40) from pocket lining holder = 46 (50, 54) sts, leave rem 49 (51, 53) sts on hold. Work in St st over 46 (50, 54) sts for a total of 16 cm, ending with a RS row and **at same time**, work first 3 side shaping incs at right edge same as for back = 49 (53, 57) sts. Place sts on holder, cut yarn. Return 49 (51, 53) held sts to size 6 mm needles and with RS facing, rejoin yarn. Next row (RS): M1R, k1, M1L, sl 1 kwise wyib, M1L, work to end = 52 (54, 56) sts. Next row (WS): Patt to last 5 sts, k1, p1, k1, two-stitch selvage. Next row (RS): Two-stitch selvage, p1, k1, p1, patt to end. Work in patt as set by last 2 rows for a total of 16 cm, ending with a WS row. Next row (RS): K2tog 3 times, patt to end = 49 (51, 53) sts. Next row (WS): Patt over 13 sts, then with holder held in front of and parallel to working needle, join pocket lining sts from holder and sts from working needle with p2tog, work to end = 62 (66, 70) sts. Work even until piece meas 37 cm from cast-on, working rem inc for side shaping at right edge same as for back = 63 (67, 71) sts. Work armhole shaping at right edge same as for back = 50 (54, 58) sts. Work even until piece meas 54 (55, 56) cm from cast-on, ending with a RS row. Shape neck: Bind off 20 sts at beg of next WS row.

Working full-fashion dec, dec 1 st at end of next 9 RS rows, then every alt RS row 2 times. **At same time**, work armhole incs at right edge same as for back and when same length as back to shoulder, shape shoulder at right edge same as for back.

Right front: Work same as left front, reversing all shaping and patt placement and omitting buttonholes.

Sleeves: With size 4 mm needles cast on 52 sts. Next row (WS): Selvage st, * p1, k1; rep from *, end selvage st. Work in rib patt as set by last row until piece meas 7 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Change to size 6 mm needles. Work in St st and shape sleeve as foll: Inc 1 st at each end of 9 (7, 7) th row, then every 8th row 1 time, then every 6th row 13 times (then every 6th row 15 times / then every 6th row 13 times, then every 4th row 3 times) = 82 (84, 86) sts. Work even until piece meas 45 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Shape sleeve cap: Bind off 4 sts at beg of next 2 rows. Working full-fashion dec, dec 1 st at each end of next 22 (23, 24) RS rows. Work 1 WS row. Bind off rem 30 sts.


Collar: With size 4 mm needles cast on 99 sts. Next row (WS): Selvage st, * p1, k1; rep from * to last 2 sts, p1, selvage st. Work in rib patt as set by last row until piece meas 8 cm from cast-on. Bind off all sts in rib.

Finishing: Pin pieces to measurements and block. Sew shoulder seams. Sew cast-on edge of collar to neck edge, easing to fit. Sew short edges of collar to bound-off edge of left and right front, matching * to * and o to o. Sew pocket linings in place on WS. Sew in sleeves. Sew side and sleeve seams. Sew on buttons.

Gauge Swatch

Before you begin ...

...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and pattern stitch for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. 12 cm x 12 cm. Cast-on and bind-off rows, as well as selvage stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would the finished pieces of the garment. Count stitches and rows over 10 cm. If your gauge swatch is too small, switch to larger needles. If your gauge swatch is too big, switch to smaller needles.
