SHRUG

**Size** 36 – 44 One size fits all.

**Materials: 600 g** of Lana Grossa **Only Cotton** (100% cotton; 110 m/50 g) in Reseda Green **(col 24)**. Size 6 mm circular needles, 60 and 120 cm long; size 5.5 mm circular needle, 60 cm long.

Slip garter selvage: On every row: SI first st kwise, k last st.

**Slip stitch selvage:** On every row: K first st, sl last st pwise wyif.

Garter st: K every row.

St st: K on RS, p on WS.

Rib patt: K2, p2.

**Eyelet rows:** Work according to chart. Numbers at right edge of chart indicate RS rows, numbers at left edge of chart indicate WS rows. Work to patt rep, work 6 sts between arrows for patt rep, work to end of chart. Rep rows 1 – 4.

Full-fashion inc: On RS rows: M1R, 1 st in from each edge.

**Back:** With size 6 mm needles cast on 80 sts. Beg and end with a WS row and working a slip garter selvage at each edge, work in garter st for 3 rows and piece meas approx. 1 cm from cast-on. Maintaining selvage sts, work in St st for 8 rows = approx. 3 cm. Shape sleeves: Working full-fashion inc, inc 1

st at each end of next 60 RS rows, then cast on 5 sts at beg of next 2 rows = 210 sts. Work even for 10.5 cm, ending with a WS row. Shape shoulders/overarms: Bind off 12 sts at beg of next 12 rows. Bind off rem 66 sts.

**Left front:** With size 6 mm needles cast on 7 sts. Beg and end with a WS row and working a slip garter selvage at each edge, work in garter st for 3 rows and piece meas approx. 1 cm from cast-on. Maintaining selvage sts, work in St st and work sleeve shaping at right edge same as for back = 72 sts. Work even until same length as back to shoulder/overarm. Shape shoulder/overarm at right edge same as for back. No sts rem.

**Right front:** Work same as for left front, reversing all shaping.

**Left front band:** With size 6 mm needles cast on 42 sts. Working a slip garter selvage at right edge and a slip st selvage at left edge, work eyelet rows according to chart until piece meas 81.5 cm. Place sts on holder.


**Right front band:** With size 6 mm needles cast on 42 sts. Working a slip st selvage st at right edge and a slip garter selvage at left edge complete as for left front band.

**Finishing:** Pin pieces to measurements and block. Join front bands with Kitchener st. Sew shoulder/overarm seams. Sleeve cuff: With size 5.5 mm circular needle pick up and k 30 sts along bottom edge of sleeve. Next row (WS): Selvage st, p1, k2, p2; rep from \* to last 4 sts, k2, p1, selvage st. Cont in rib patt as established until cuff meas 15 cm. Loosely bind off all sts in rib. Sew side and sleeve seams. Matching • to •, \* to \* and + to + on schematic, sew front and neckband to right front, back neck and left front edge.





### Gauge Swatch

#### Before you begin ...

...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and pattern stitch for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. 12 cm x 12 cm. Cast-on and bind-off rows, as well as selvage stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would the finished pieces of the garment. Count stitches and rows over 10 cm. If your gauge swatch is too small, switch to larger needles. If your gauge swatch is too big, switch to smaller needles.
